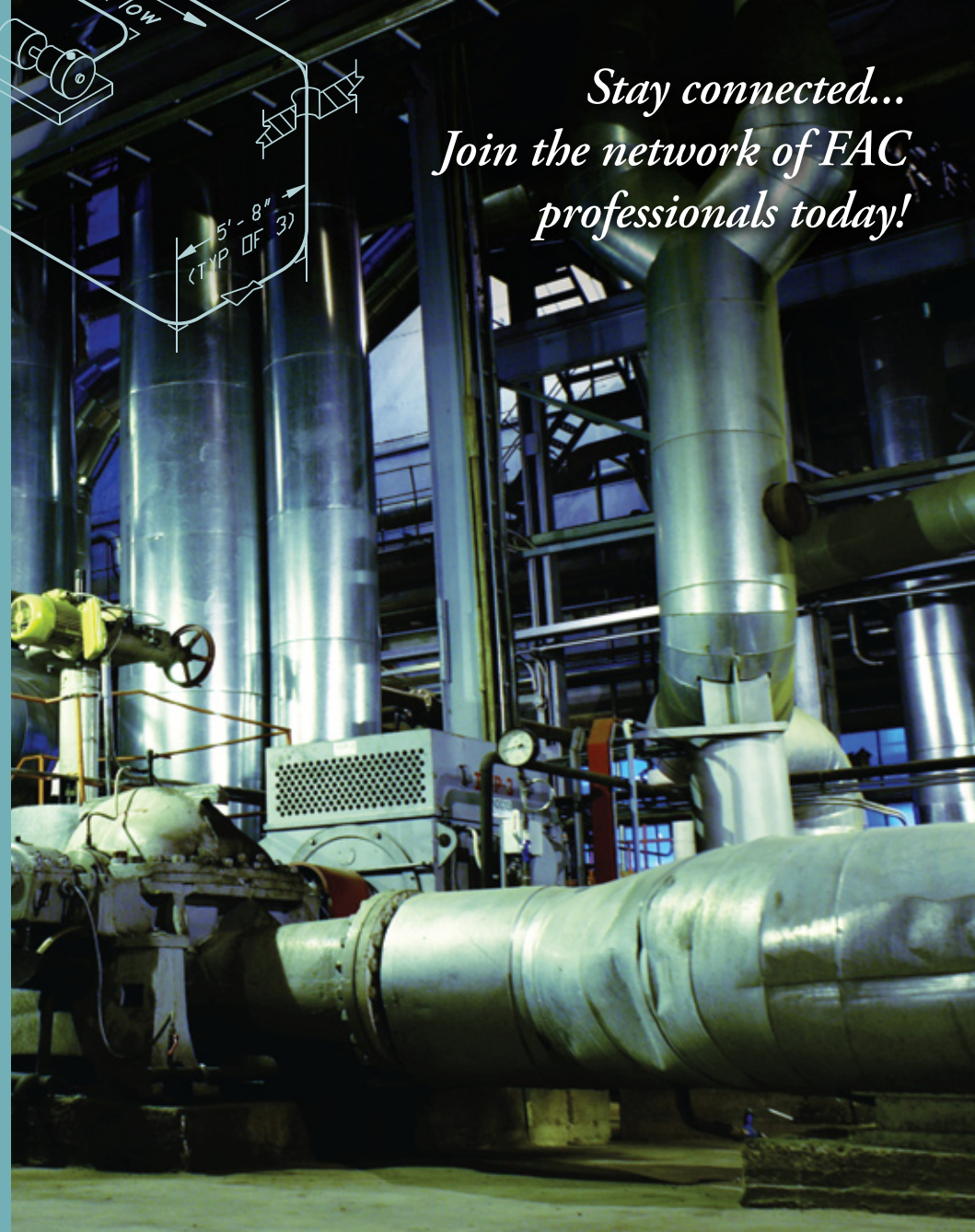

What is FACnet?

FACnet is a powerful communications tool used by utility FAC personnel to ask questions, share ideas, and exchange information. Best of all, no action is required on your part; the information comes right to your e-mail inbox.

How does it work?

FACnet uses your existing e-mail account to communicate with other FAC Program Engineers around the world. Any member of FACnet can send information to the entire membership. To ask a question you simply send an e-mail message to FACnet, which then forwards the message to the membership.

For example, if you want to know how others are responding to a certain industry event, you could pose that question to the membership. Or if you have had success with a new NDE technique, you could share that information.

To answer a question or send follow-up information, you simply read and respond to your e-mail.

What does FACnet do for me?

First, you have access to the experience of hundreds of FAC professionals. Whatever technical issue you are facing, it is likely that someone has seen it before and can offer you some insight.

Second, after an industry FAC event, FACnet provides you with up-to-date information. When an event occurs, you need to know what happened – immediately. As a member of FACnet, you will be on top of things and able to respond to your management.

Third, you can receive and contribute information on new FAC-related issues and techniques. For example, polyacrylic acid and upgrades to SFA have been topics of recent interest.

Finally, all FACnet messages are posted on a password-protected web site. This means you can access and search the information even if you delete your messages.

I already get too much e-mail. Will FACnet clutter up my e-mail inbox?

No. The amount of e-mail traffic is usually small. Also, most e-mail software will allow you to set up a separate inbox for FACnet messages only. Of course, your e-mail address will not be shared with anyone except other FACnet members and you may discontinue your membership at any time.

How much does it cost?

FACnet is free to all eligible members.

Who is eligible?

Any utility employee with an interest in the field of FAC may join.
